Policy

Access to use University laboratory computer systems is available to all current students, faculty, administration and alumni.

Upon entry, a current student must present a valid University of Detroit Mercy identification card to the student assistant managing the lab. A card is only valid if the current term sticker is displayed on the back of the card. The current term sticker is available from the Student Life Office.

Alumni must display a valid alumni identification card.

Faculty and administration must display a valid employee identification card.

Access is not available to students without a valid University of Detroit Mercy identification card, students from other schools, or the children and relatives of a valid University of Detroit Mercy student.

A Michigan Driver's License may not be substituted for the University of Detroit Mercy identification card.

During class sessions hosted in the laboratories, students need not present their valid identification to attend the class.

Regulations

Failure to produce valid identification (as defined above) will result in denial of access.
